

### All-State Publication Awards: Newspaper and Yearbook

- Newspapers, Online News Sites, and Yearbooks will be judged based on the appropriate rubric and overall quality of publication.
- All submitted work will receive feedback.
- Contest entries will be judged in two categories: 1A/2A and 3A/4A.
- All entries will be rated for a Golden Pony, Silver Spur, or Bronze Star, and the top two in each category (Newspaper & Yearbook) will earn All-State Winner and All-State Runner-up.

- Newspaper:
  - o Advisor will submit the entire Online News Site via the URL. If printed, then PDFs of three (3) entire printed issues should be submitted.
  - o PDFs should be titled Division\_Contest\_School\_Year.pdf
    - ex: 2A\_AbsarokaHS\_NewspaperA\_2022.pdf
- Yearbook:
  - Advisor will submit the entire Yearbook as a PDF document. The cover may or may not be included in this PDF.
    - If the cover is not included in the PDF, then a photo or second PDF of the Yearbook Cover should be submitted as well.
  - o The PDF should be titled Division\_Contest\_School\_Year.pdf
    - ex: 2A\_AbsarokaHS\_Yearbook\_2022.pdf



## All-State Publication Contests

- The Design Contest is meant to showcase the design and layout skills for students working on Yearbook material.
  - This means that the work completed on a yearbook spread layout/online design is created/completed in majority by the student.
- Portfolio pieces may be:
  - whole spreads or layouts from the yearbook, or individual design pieces, such as graphics, charts, artwork, alternate copy elements, etc.
  - If only submitting a single element, the element should be surrounded by a red box, etc to draw the judges attention to it.
- Portfolios will be judged based on appropriate rubrics and overall quality of the student's work.
- Contest entries will be judged in two categories: 1A/2A and 3A/4A.
- All entries will be rated for a Golden Pony, Silver Spur, or Bronze Star, and the top two portfolios in each category will earn All-State Winner and All-State Runner-up.

- Student Portfolio MUST be a PDF that includes a MINIMUM of 3 work samples and a MAXIMUM of 5 work samples. Portfolios that contain fewer than three or more than 5 will not be considered for awards.
- All spreads should be included in the same PDF as a portfolio. Individual documents will not be accepted.
- Submission should be named with the division, students' first and last name, underscore, school name, contest name.
  - Ex: 4A\_BonnieSmith\_SkyviewHS\_YearbookPortfolio.pdf

- Contest designed for showcasing the photography skills for students working on Publications material. Publications material includes Yearbook, Newspaper, Magazine, Broadcast, etc.
- All photographs submitted must be connected in some way to publication material.
- Portfolios will be judged based on the photography rubric, as well as overall quality of the student's work.
- Contest entries will be judged in two categories: 1A/2A and 3A/4A.
- All entries will be rated for a Golden Pony, Silver Spur, or Bronze Star, and the top two portfolios in each category will earn All-State Winner and All-State Runner-up.

- Photographs must be included in the PDF and should be titled, with a description of how the photo was used in a publication.
  - Ex: "Hometown Rivalry" Used in Yearbook spread for homecoming coverage.
- PDF portfolio that includes a MINIMUM of 3 and MAXIMUM of 5 original photographs taken by the student and for use in a publication.
- All photos MUST be included in one PDF portfolio. Individual photo files will not be accepted.
- Submission should be named with the division, students first name, last name, underscore, school name, contest name.
  - Ex: 4A\_BonnieSmith\_SkyviewHS\_Photography\_Portfolio.pdf







# All-State Publication Contests

- Contest designed for showcasing the video or broadcast skills for students working on student broadcast publications.
- This means that the work completed in the video/broadcast is created/completed in majority by the student.
- Portfolios will be judged based on the design rubrics, as well as overall quality of the student's work. Contest entries will be judged in two categories: 1A/2A and 3A/4A.
- All entries will be rated for a Golden Pony, Silver Spur, or Bronze Star, and the top two portfolios in each category will earn All-State Winner and All-State Runner-up.

#### **Submission Requirements**

- Portfolio must be posted online and a link to that portfolio shared for submission. Video files should not be uploaded.
- Portfolio MUST include a MINIMUM of 3 and a MAXIMUM of 5 video/broadcast segments created/designed in majority by the student.

- Contest designed for showcasing the writing skills for students working on student publications material.
- Writing samples can be written work completed for yearbook, broadcast, newspaper, podcast, etc.
- Portfolio pieces may be any written piece created for a yearbook, newspaper, broadcast, podcast, etc.
- Portfolios will be judged based on writing rubrics, as well as overall quality of the student's work.
- Contest entries will be judged in two categories: 1A/2A and 3A/4A.
- All entries will be rated for a Golden Pony, Silver Spur, or Bronze Star, and the top two portfolios in each category will earn All-State Winner and All-State Runner-up.

- Portfolio MUST be a PDF document that contains a MINIMUM of 3 and a MAXIMUM of 5 writing samples written by the student.
- All articles MUST be in the same PDF as a portfolio. Individual documents will not be considered for awards.
- Submission should be named with the division, students first name, last name, underscore, school name, contest name.
  - Ex: 4A BonnieSmith SkyviewHS Writing Portfolio.pdf

### **Creating Portfolios for Submissions**

- Writing, Yearbook, and Photography Portfolios must be ONE PDF DOCUMENT that contains all work samples.
  - a. We suggest students use Canva to create their portfolios, as they can either copy and paste work in, or take photos of work and place them in the document.
  - b. If you take photos of the work, make sure to do so at a high enough resolution that the judges can read/see it.
- 2. If you navigate to the website, you'll find some helpful videos on how to create a portfolio in Canva.

### **Submissions**

- 1. Create all necessary PDF documents and name appropriately.
  - a. Please use the name formats listed above. This is very important for helping us keep all entries organized.
- 2. For the whole yearbook, please email or share the PDF with whsspaboard@gmail.com.
- 3. For the newspaper, please email the link to the online publication.
- 4. For writing, yearbook, and photography portfolios, please email or share your entry PDFs with whsspaboard@gmail.com.
- 5. For video portfolios, please email the link the online portfolio, clearly indicating which link belongs to which student.
  - a.Do not share or email individual video files. They are too large and cumbersome this way.
- 6. If you have any trouble with submissions, please email us. We'll happily help you get things turned in.
- 7. We will email you in response to let you know we received your entries.

### **On-the-Spot Contests**

- The day of convention, there will be three On-the-Spot Contests:
  - People's Choice Award
  - Journalism Writing
  - Photo-Journalism
- These will begin after the keynote session and end just before closing.

#### People's Choice Award

- Advisors may submit a Yearbook or printed newspaper for consideration in People's choice.
- Publications will be laid out for advisors and staffs to consider. Each school will be able to cast one vote for newspaper and yearbook each.
- Winners will be announced during closing session.

#### **Journalism Writing**

- Students will be tasked with a writing assignment relevant to the day of convention. They will have a set time during the day to complete their assignment and return to the judge.
- Winners will be announced during closing session.

#### **Photo-Journalism**

- Students will be tasked with a photo journalism assignment relevant to the day of convention. They will have a set time during the day to complete their assignment and return to the judge.
- Winners will be announced during closing session.

\*\*\*On-the-Spot Contests will be run at the discretion of the organizers, the WSMA Board. Changes may be made to this line-up as needed and any pertinent information will be provided at the start of convention.\*\*\*
